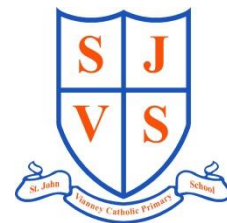




Sports Funding



Sports Premium Funding Following the legacy from the Olympic and Paralympic Games, the Government has again this year made significant funds available in order to improve school sports provision throughout the country and to improve the fitness levels of pupils.

During the financial year 2019/2020 St John Vianney Catholic Primary School has been allocated the following funds of £17,777 A summary of the planned spend is shown below
